AUTHORIZATION OF PERMIT

SPECIAL PROVISIONS

1. Flags, lights and barricades shall be erected to protect traffic and persons, if necessary.
2. Traffic to be allowed to pass and to be protected at all times. If it is not possible to allow traffic to pass, a suitable detour must be provided.
3. All traffic control devices to be erected in a manner which will provide suitable visibility in all directions and shall be in accordance with the Minnesota Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices including Appendix B, dated September, 1985.
4. If blasting is required, precautions must be exercised.
5. Excavations must be cribbed when necessary in order to prevent cave-ins.
6. No guys or stays to be attached to trees in County Highway right of way.
7. Underground construction must be so constructed as not to harm or unnecessarily destroy the root growth of sightly or ornamental trees.
8. No trenching across roadways will be permitted under this application.
9. If surfacing or roadway is damaged, same shall be restored to original condition.
10. Concrete and bituminous pavement to be replaced according to State and County Specifications.
11. No pole anchors, anchor braces or other construction to be put on roadway shoulder.
12. No driving on the highway from ditch or driving on shoulders if damage will occur.

13. No lugs shall be used on equipment traveling on road which will damage the road surface.
14. Roadside and right-of-way shall be cleaned up when completed, and returned to original condition.
15. If the County Highway Department makes any improvements or changes on all or any part of its right of way upon, over, under, or along The County State Aid Highway or County Road, then and in every case the applicant herein named shall after notice from the County Highway Engineer or his/her authorized agents proceed to alter, change, vacate or remove from the right of way said works to conform with County changes without cost whatsoever to Red Lake County.
16. No work shall be done which will create a nuisance.
17. After work on a project is completed applicant shall notify the County Highway Department that such work has been completed and ready for final inspection and acceptance by Red Lake County Highway Department.
18. The Red Lake County Highway department has no responsibility for the well being of objects placed on the right-of-way. The county highway department cannot be held responsible for any harm that may come to projects placed within the county highway department's right-of-way.
19. Special Conditions: The Red Lake County Highway Department shall be notified when the work is to take place to enable a representative from the highway department to be present to ensure structure is placed out of recovery area.
